## ADDRESS APPLICATION WORKFLOW AND SCHEDULE

- 1) The Land Owner completes the application and includes a plot plan or GIS map with their driveway location clearly marked.
- 2) The applicant submits the application along with the associated fee(s) to the Lafayette County Land Information Department. The fee covers the cost of the sign(s), sign post(s) (if needed) and installation.
- 3) The Land Information Department assigns the rural address and forwards the new address on the property owner and all other affected departments including E911.
- 4) Lafayette County orders the new sign. Sometimes new sign orders can take a couple of months before the order is complete and the sign can be installed. If necessary, the Land Owner may erect a temporary sign until the new sign is installed. **Remember to call \*811 to check with Digger's Hotline prior to installing sign posts.**
- 5) Lafayette County Highway Department will install the new sign and sign post if necessary.
