
Radon

Radon is a naturally occurring, colorless, odorless radioactive gas that causes lung cancer. Approximately **52**% of radon tests done in Lafayette County homes are above the US EPA guideline of 4 pCi/L.

The only way to know the radon level in a house is to measure it. If you are a Lafayette County resident, **FREE** kits are available at the Health Department.

Information on Radon Levels in Lafayette County: The average national indoor radon level is 1.3 pCi/L. The average indoor radon levels of Lafayette County, as determined by radon test results from Air Chek, is 6.4 pCi/L
