**Fire/Ambulance Reports-** The tanker truck will arrive in October. Kendall Township will owe approximately \$30,000 for the balance. Brandon Masbruch is retiring at the end of the year as ambulance chief. Not sure who will replace him at this time.

**Discussion on road projects for the year-** The County started work on Prairie Road and North Lane. Should finish up this week.

**Discussion on the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)-** This was discussed at the Towns Meeting on July 26<sup>th</sup>. The first reporting is due this fall. Guidelines on what the money can be spent on keeps changing. It could be used for emergency management resources within the County.

**Discussion and possible action on contracting diesel for winter-** The Township usually contracts some diesel. The contract for the upcoming winter is \$2.62/gallon.
