Patrolman's Update: The patrolmen have replaced and fixed some signs. They returned some tailings. They cleaned up the Town Hall for the election and cleaned out the back shed. Bill fixed the brakes on the red truck. They have put some gravel down.

Old Business:

Fire/Ambulance Reports- Getting newer lights for the old tanker truck to match the lights on the new tanker truck. The Fire Department bought 3 pairs of steel reinforced boots. There were 16 Ambulance Service calls in March. There is a new EMR that completed training. The pancake breakfast is May 15th.

Discussion on road maintenance projects for this year: The estimated cost to seal coat is \$18,000/mile. In order to maintain the patching, and ditching work the Township has previously done in the past couple of years, Airport Road, Deery Road, McCarville Lane and Russell Road are the

projects that are being looked at first. Have not received state LRIP funding approval yet for Cottage Inn Road reconstruction, so this will likely be next year.

New Business:

Discussion on funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). The first filing deadline is April 30th, 2022. The Township has not spent any of the funds to date but most of this funding will be used for a new Belmont ambulance being delivered later this fall.

Discussion on Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) WisDot. Based on meetings with the state, county and webinars, it does not appear that any townships will qualify for these Federal Infrastructure funds. These federal funds are being directed to very large projects that require engineering and cost values that far exceed many township budgets. The county is looking into these funds further but currently it is not looking favorable for small township communities.
