WHEREAS, Lafayette County is interested in maintaining, acquiring, insuring and developing aids for public snowmobile and ATV/UTV trail use on the Tri-County Trail; and

WHEREAS, said public snowmobile and ATV/UTV trails are eligible for funds under section 23.09(26), Wisconsin Statutes.


