

RESOLUTION 64 - 23

ESTABLISHING 2025 THROUGH 2028 ELECTED OFFICIALS' SALARIES FOR COUNTY CLERK, TREASURER AND REGISTER OF DEEDS

WHEREAS, the County Partisan Offices of Treasurer, Register of Deeds and County Clerk are up for election this year at the November 5, 2024 General Election; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 59.22(1)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, provides that "Prior to the earliest time for filing nomination papers" the County Board shall "establish the total annual compensation for services to be paid to our elected officials;" and

WHEREAS, by action of the State of Wisconsin, the positions of Treasurer, Register of Deeds and County Clerk, serve a four-year term with the term of office beginning in January of 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Lafayette County Joint Finance Committee and Human Resource Committee, met on February 14, 2024, and considered the requested salaries and recommended that the Treasurer, Register of Deeds and County Clerk receive a 4% increase in 2025, a 4% increase in 2026, a 15% increase in 2027, and an 8% increase in 2028.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lafayette County Board of Supervisors, at the request of the Joint Finance Committee and Human Resource Committee, hereby recommend the following salaries for the Treasurer, Register of Deeds and County Clerk, for the years 2025, 2026, 2027 and 2028, effective January 1 of each year, as listed below; and


FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, no elected official shall be entitled to keep any fee or other service charge paid to their office as part of or in addition to the above established salary; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the Treasurer and County Clerk are entitled to collect a per diem for any meeting convened after normal working hours when they are acting in their official capacity; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that no reduction in salary will occur during any elected official's term as a result of this resolution.
