**Clerk/Treasurer's Report:** The bills for August were presented for payment. Motion made by Joe Fogel to approve the clerk/treasurer report and approve the bills payable. Reggie Kamps seconded the motion. All Ayes. Motion Carries.

**Patrolman Update:** The patrolmen have put gravel down on Cottage Inn Road and Prairie Road. They have done some patching and ditching. Rain took out the edge of New Line Road and left mud. The Red Truck is back. The Town is looking into listing the Orange Truck on WI Surplus.

## **Old Business:**

**Fire/Ambulance Reports-** The Belmont Fire District met with the insurance agent to discuss increasing the insurance on fireman in case of injury or death. The Fire District purchased a new generator for \$7800. They also spent \$3050 on repaving and repainting the driveway.

**Update on March 2019 Flood Damage Claim-** The County is patching the roads. The estimated cost of repairs to Oak Park Road and Rock Road was \$13-\$14,000. The final cost is \$11,686. Kendall Township should get back 70% of the cost of the claim from the State.

**Russell Road Bridge replacement update-** The road was raised because there was too much limestone underneath. Mark talked with Tom Jean about doing blacktop this year or next year. The Road Closed signs are still up, but the road can be driven on. VW Fencing is going to do the fencing and the flood gate underneath the bridge.

**Seal coating & blacktop mats update-** The County has most of the mats and wedges in. They will be back to finish Russell Road and Cottage Inn.

**Rural Mutual Insurance-** At the August 26<sup>th</sup> Special Meeting, the change to Rural Mutual Insurance Company for the Town insurance was approved. Saving the township 34% in premium cost, helped by lower claims and no lawsuits the last couple of years.

**Future changes Town Dump-** The Town is going to check into where the septic lines at the Town Shed are so changes to the driveway can be made to make traffic flow better at the dump, as well as to make things easier for the patrolmen when loading chips or gravel.

## **New Business:**

**Advertising for third part-time patrolman-** At the September 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019 Special Meeting it was approved to advertise in the Republican Journal and the Shopping News for a third part-time patrolman.

**Recycling Change-** Faherty's has informed the Town of some changes in recycling. Only "1" and "2" plastics will be taken as recycling. Also there will be a 3% increase for next year.

**Public Comment:** An elector suggested talking to Waste Management for the trash and recycling for the Town of Kendall for possible reduced cost and more acceptance of various recyclable materials.

Reggie Kamps made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Joe Fogel seconded it. All Ayes.  
Meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
