Discussion and possible action on road maintenance projects for the year- Scott's are behind in work on Truman Road. Scott's still believes they will have the mats done in time for the road to settle and be seal coated pre the contract requirements before cold weather sets in.

Discussion on the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)- Kendall has received the first payment. Rules have changed, and the money can be in an interest bearing account. The money was deposited into a separate money market account earning .25% interest.

New Business:

Discussion and possible action on contracting LP for Fall- The LP contract needs to signed if the Township wishes to contract LP for the winter season.
