Fire/Ambulance Reports- Belmont Fire District is still planning on having the Fireman's Dance. They are looking at Memorial Day Weekend, and are thinking of holding it outdoors.

Discussion on road maintenance projects for the year- The Town is looking at doing approximately 2 ½ miles of additional seal coat besides Truman Road this summer. The roads to be

worked on are Oak Park Road, North Lane and Prairie Roads. Truman Road is being worked on with the LRIP project supplement funds. The Town may ask Scott's to see what they would charge to seal coat roads along Truman Road while they are there.
