  - 1. **Timmerman, Michael.** Parcel:004.0255.0000. After-the-fact building permit Motion by Buchs to approve After-the-fact building application. Second by Clayton; motion passed 3-0.
  - 2. **Stoltzfus, Amos K**. Parcel: 004.0037.5000. New greenhouse building application. Motion by Clayton to approve Greenhouse building application. Second by Buchs; motion passed 3-0.
  - 3. **Tippett, Francis**. Parcel: 004.0186.1310. Zoning variance Motion by Bonin to support the zoning variance. Second by Clayton; motion passed 3-0.
- b. Platteville Fire / EMS (Ryan Simmons) Platteville City Council awarded the RFP for design services to Wendel Five Bugles Design. The City Manager is currently working with the USDA to secure the \$7 Million in federal aid. The City is also looking for other funding options for the new building. It received a large donation from a private citizen.
- c. Belmont Fire / EMS (Supervisor Buchs) There were 15 calls last month, new

- purchase: \$11,000 for battery powered equipment paid for with Fire Dance money
- d. County Planning and Zoning update County Planning and Zoning Department is requesting all zoned townships to approve zoning permits first at Town level before the County. Currently, zoning permits are first approved at County level in Town of Belmont. Board supports Planning Commission's recommendation to keep it this way.

- b. Review other needs
  - i. Motion by Buchs to accept Iverson Construction's bid for wedging at following roads: entire Bonner Rd, Mitchell Hollow Rd. (box culvert), parts of Heins Rd, parts of Cottage Inn Rd; 308 tons total at \$110/ton for \$34,0000. Bonin second; motion passed 3-0.
  - ii. Motion by Clayton to accept Lafayette County's quote for chip sealing at following locations: .6 mile on Sunny Ln (double shot), .6 mile on Hickory Rd. (bridge to Cty G), 1.2 mile on Ipswitch (double shot), .6 mile on Mitchell Hollow Rd. East, 1 mile on E. Mound Rd; 4 miles total at app. \$18,200/mile for \$72,800 total. Clayton second; motion passed 3-0.
  - iii. Motion by Clayton to accept J&T Concrete Construction LLC bid for resurfacing entire W. Commerce block in front of Town Hall, including sidewalks, making it ADA compliant for \$17,856. Second by Buchs; motion passed 3-0.

Updated Driveway Ordinance Motion by Buchs to adopt Ordinance No. 2022-02: An Ordinance to Repeal and Recreate Ordinance No. 2015-04 Related to the Establishment of Private and Public Road Construction and Town Highway Access Standards in the Town of Belmont, Lafayette County, Wisconsin, and to Establish Penalties for Violation Thereof. Second by Clayton; motion passed 3-0.
