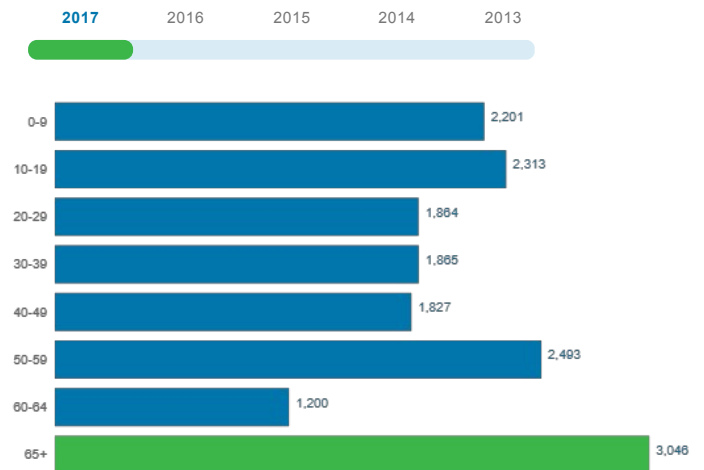

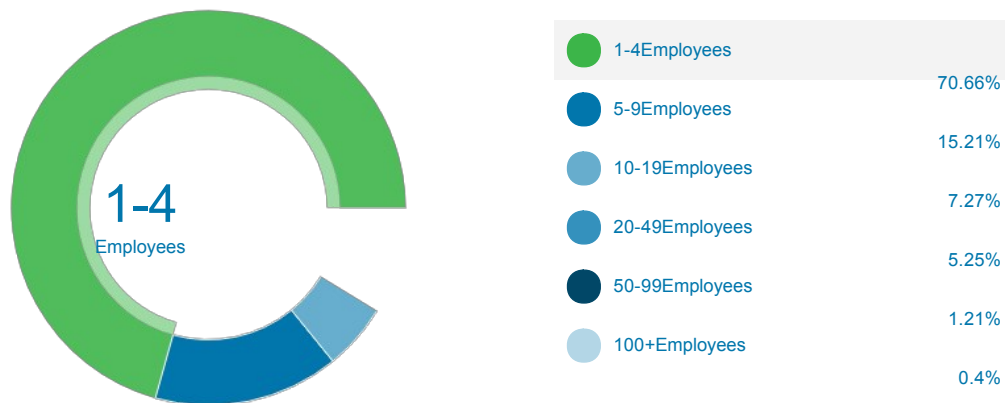
Businesses and Jobs

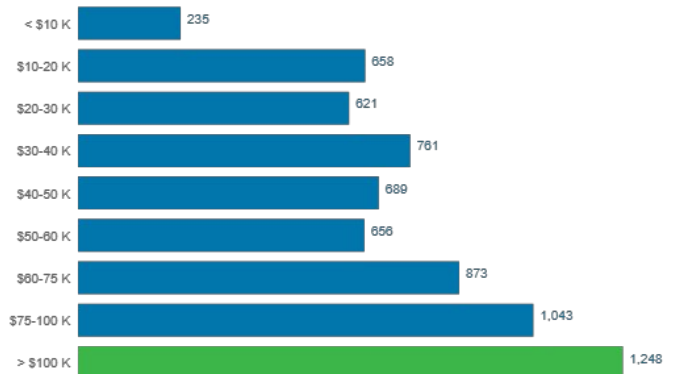

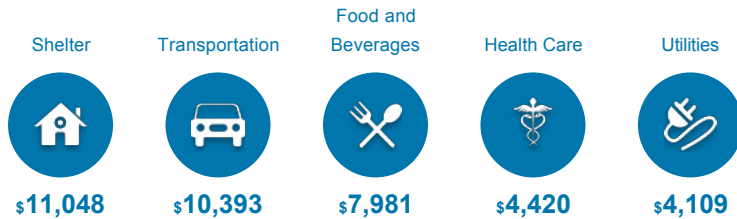

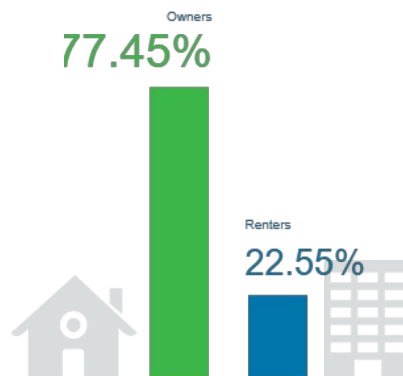
